Karen Blooding teaches music and directs the choirs at Homer Pittard Campus School and is an adjunct instructor for the MTSU School of Music. Ms. Blooding conducts children's choir festivals around the Southeast region, and has served as the Tennessee ACDA Chair for Children's Choir Repertoire and Standards and as Elementary/General Music Chair for Tennessee Music Educators Association. She was named Tennessee's Teacher of the Year in 2005 and is a National Board Certified Teacher in Early and Middle Childhood Music.

The TVW, originally the Murfreesboro Community Concert Band, was organized in 1984 for area musicians who had played in high school and college bands but who were now without a performance outlet. Joseph T. Smith, founding director and conductor from 1984-2000, led the group through many notable performances including the Midwest Clinic International Band Conference, The Tennessee Music Educators Association Convention, the Schermerhorn Symphony Hall and was even a featured performance group in London, England.

The TVW, now conducted by Terry Jolley, enjoys a most enviable reputation. The group performs several concerts in Murfreesboro each year and travels to other communities in Middle Tennessee and Southern Kentucky.

The purpose and objectives of the TVW are:

To make a positive contribution to the musical environment and culture of Middle Tennessee,

To provide an opportunity for a quality musical experience and musical growth by membership,

To provide an opportunity for contact and interaction with musicians of advanced proficiency by the membership,

To advance the position of the community concert band in America through public performances of quality band literature.



Terry Jolley is currently co-director of the Siegel Middle School Band. Prior to this appointment, he served as a music educator at Blackman High School in Murfreesboro, Middle Tennessee State University in Murfreesboro, John Overton High School in Nashville, and as director of bands at Warren County High School in McMinnville, TN. Terry continues to serve as a guest conductor and clinician throughout the Southeast and is an active consultant for numerous bands. He has served as Director of The Governor's School for the Arts and is currently the conductor of the Tennessee Valley Winds. Terry has been awarded four citations of excellence by the National Band Association, was selected to Who's Who Among American Teachers in 1994 and 1996, and was inducted into the MTSU Band of Blue Club Hall of Fame in 2000.

Terry is a member of the National Band Association, Music Educator's National Conference, Tennessee Band Director's Association, Tennessee Music Education Association, Middle Tennessee School Band & Orchestra Association, West Tennessee School Band & Orchestra Association, East Tennessee School Band & Orchestra Association, and the International Association of Jazz Educators.
