MURFREESBORO COMMUNITY CONCERT BAND

The Murfreesboro Community Concert Band, under the direction of Joseph Smith, was formed in 1984 to provide a performance outlet for the many adult musicians in the area. The membership includes band directors, teachers, university students, and professional people who hail from all areas of middle Tennessee and southern Kentucky. The band has twice performed at the Tennessee Music Educators Association's annual In-Service Conference and at the All-State Wind Ensemble Conference in addition to its many performances in the Murfreesboro area. In its brief history the band has enjoyed having such guest conductors as Karel Husa, Claude T. Smith, W.J. Julian, and Howard Nicar. Dr. Ron Nelson is scheduled to appear with the band in February during the Middle Tennessee State University Wind Ensemble Conference. Committed to performing music of contemporary composers, the organization is steeped in the tradition of the community band. Each program is planned to please a variety of musical tastes while stimulating the emotional senses of the listener.

JOSEPH T. SMITH, CONDUCTOR

As professor of music at Middle Tennessee State University, Joseph T. Smith directs the marching band, concert band, and wind ensemble. In addition to his long tenure at the University, he directed high school instrumental programs in Tennessee and Georgia prior to his present position.

Mr. Smith has served as conductor, adjudicator, or clinician in twenty-six states, Mexico, and Canada. For several years he conducted workshops at the prestigious VanderCook School of Music. He is well known as founding director of the Contest of Champions, which is viewed internationally via educational television, and the All-State Wind Ensemble Conference. He is the recipient of the N.B.A. "Citation of Excellence" and the Third Army distinguished service award; is a national patron of Delta Omicron; is listed in the *Dictionary of International Biography* Cambridge, England; was featured in the *School Musician*; and was honored as a Distinguished Alumnus of Middle Tennessee State University. He holds membership in local and national music associations, Phi Beta Mu, Phi Mu Alpha, and the American Bandmasters Association.
